Indie rock is a genre of rock music that originated in the United Kingdom in the s. Originally used to describe independent record labels, the term became associated with the music they produced and was initially used interchangeably with "alternative rock". Stylistic origins: Alternative rock, indie pop, post-punk, college rock. Books in Lucent's Music Library focus on the music, the musicians, the instruments, and on music's place in cultural history. For most music fans, terms such as modern rock, alternative, and indie are synonymous ways of describing this popular subgenre.
